

QTC Wins Further Export Orders

21 September 2016, Melbourne: Traffic Technologies Limited (TTI or the Company) is pleased to announce that its subsidiary company, Quick Turn Circuits (QTC) has recently won significant export orders from China in addition to the \$2.2m export order for traffic controllers for Singapore announced in July.

The orders for a total of \$1.1m are for the Shanghai and Pudong markets in Mainland China with delivery to be completed within the first half of the current financial year. These orders are in addition to recent export orders from Hong Kong, New Zealand, Qatar, Jordan, Kenya and Ecuador and continue the Company's export strategy of opening up new markets where demand may also exist for the Group's other products such as traffic signals, pedestrian countdown timers and electronic signage.

QTC's traffic controller is an automated device that regulates the sequencing and timing of traffic signals by monitoring vehicular and pedestrian demands and adjusting to meet these requirements. The controller has the ability to allow co-ordination of traffic flows between adjacent intersections when connected to a coordinated adaptive traffic system. QTC's traffic controller is based on the Sydney Coordinated Adaptive Traffic System (known as SCATS) which is used and operated in 27 countries and 37,000 intersections worldwide.

QTC's position as a major supplier of traffic controllers in the Australian market has been enhanced with approval now obtained for its product in some States where approval had not been received. The company expects continuing sales growth for its products in the local market as well as overseas in the months ahead.
