Mitula Group Limited ("Mitula" or the "Company") (ASX:MUA) advises that a total of 4,349,213 new fully paid ordinary shares (Consideration Shares) have been issued as detailed in the accompanying Appendix 3B.

On 5 September 2016, the Company announced the acquisition of 100% of the issued share capital of DotProperty Pte Ltd. The Consideration Shares form part of the consideration payable in connection with the acquisition of Dot Property Pte Ltd.

A total of 827,987 Consideration Shares are subject to voluntary escrow arrangements for a period of 6 months from the date of issue. The balance of the Consideration Shares will be subject to a voluntary escrow period of 12 months.
