NOTICE OF UNMARKETABLE PARCEL PROCESS

Mustang Resources Limited (ASX:**MUS**) ("**Mustang**" or the "**Company**") announces that its share registrar Computershare has informed the Company that all Share Retention Forms received from holders of less than a marketable parcel have now been collated under the process in relation to unmarketable parcels as announced to the ASX on 30 August 2016 pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 15.13.

A total of 3,826 shareholdings of unmarketable parcels aggregating 1,386,025 shares will now be offered for sale through the Company's appointed broker, Hartley's Limited.
