




Corporate Structure



Management Structure









Rationalize Product Lines


- Austco has more that 900 products in its portfolio
- Typically with companies that have many products, 80% of sales come from only 20% of those products
- Over 29 years, Austco has continued to add products to its portfolio while removing few
- Rationalize Austro products to approximately 300

Introduce Subscription Pricing Model

Benefits for Azure:


- Predictable and continuous revenue

A Software as a Product (SaaP) company's revenue is a function of the number of new customers while the Software as a Service (SaaS) company's revenue is a function of the total number of customers.





GLOBAL NURSE CALL SYSTEMS MARKET, 2012 - 2020, REVENUE (USD Mil)










Alarm metrics for units within a given facility, along with facility totals.

Bar graphs representing staff who have answered the most and the fewest calls






Shift Compare
