> Orinoco report that the last of the construction equipment is now on site which will allow for completion of the gravity circuit in June. The remaining construction work is to commence this week.

Levels 0 and 1 have been developed and are currently available for mining.

Development continues to advance towards Level 2 of the mine from both the main incline shaft and the internal ramp

Abundant spectacular visible gold has been observed in production areas in Level 1 North, Central and Level 1 South - approximately 80m along strike from each other. (See figure 1 below).

Gold from panning an advance in Slot 2, Level 1 North. Right: Samples from the wall of the slot raise, and samples caught in the screen prior to panning from the same location. Panel samples indicated that this stope was low-medium grade. It has now been re-categorised as very high-grade following initial stope development.

Following the final construction of the gravity circuit by a Brazilian construction crew and team members from Gekko Systems Australia, commissioning is scheduled for the last half of June, with first gold to be poured during July.
