## **VARIATION TO JV AGREEMENT WITH NEWMONT**

**Quantum Resources Limited (ASX: QUR)** ("QUR" or the "Company") is pleased to announce that the Company has entered into a Deed of Variation and Joint Venture agreement with Newmont Tanami Pty Ltd ("Newmont") covering the Officer Hill tenement in the Northern Territory. Under the Deed of Variation, Newmont is required to spend \$500,000 over 3 years to earn a 70% interest (previously Newmont had the right to earn up to a 75% interest)

As announced in 2006, previous explorers located sporadic mineralization from drilling such 4 metres @ 4.64g/t, numerous short intervals of 1-4g/t, and several wide intercepts of 0.1-1g/t. The prospect is considered to have excellent potential to host steeply plunging shoots such as those at the Tanami Gold Mine. An apparent fold closure to the east offers the possibility of discovery of Callie-style mineralization at depth.

The Company's Managing Director, Mr Avi Kimelman said: "The Officer Hill tenement is highly prospective for gold and possibly other minerals. We are pleased to have re-negotiated terms on the joint venture that are favourable for our shareholders and solidifies our working relationship with Newmont".

All other terms under the Joint Venture Agreement remain the same.
