Appointment of GHD to complete an Environmental Impact Statement for Ammaroo Phosphate Project

Rum Jungle Resources Ltd (RUM) is pleased to announce the appointment of GHD Pty Ltd ("GHD") as lead consultant in the development and submission of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Ammaroo Phosphate Project. The EIS process will be coordinated out of GHD's Darwin Office and will be progressed in parallel with the Bankable Feasibility Study. It is expected that the EIS process will take approximately 12-15 months to complete.
