USA update

Medical Developments International Limited (ASX: MVP) has been in contact with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) regarding its submission, which has advised:

1. The FDA is delayed in its responses to nearly all submissions as a result of Division of Anesthesia, Analgesia, and Addiction Products (“DAAAP”) workload. The FDA estimates a delay in its response until the end of June.
2. The FDA confirmed the delay is not related to Pentrox.
3. The FDA indicated that MVP was “well placed”, as many other FDA responses are being delayed to September.

MVP CEO, Mr. John Sharman said; “The feedback from the FDA is not unexpected given the epidemic of narcotic addiction in the USA and the political pressure this is generating. We are encouraged by the informal feedback that the review of our non-narcotic Pentrox is towards the top of the list. We will keep the market informed.”

'Pentrox' is a fast onset, non-opioid analgesic indicated for pain relief by self-administration in patients with trauma and those requiring analgesia for surgical procedures. 'Pentrox' has been used safely and effectively for more than 30 years in Australia with excess of 5.0 million units sold. There is growing interest in 'Pentrox' being used in patients undergoing investigatory procedures, as well as operational procedures such as colonoscopy.
