\$1.1 MILLION RAISED FROM SHARE PURCHASE PLAN

Silver City Minerals Limited (ASX: SCI) (**Silver City** or **Company**) advises that the share purchase plan (**SPP**) launched on 6 June 2016 closed on 27 June 2016. The Company received applications for a total of 24,833,271 ordinary shares representing proceeds of \$1,117,500 from the SPP.

This significantly exceeds the target \$500,000 originally envisaged by the board in the share placement announcement on 30 May 2016.

The SPP provided shareholders with the opportunity to purchase shares in the Company at the same issue price as the institutions that participated in the share placement announced on 30 May 2016, which raised \$785,000 (**Placement**).

The funds raised from the SPP and Placement will be utilised to fund a comprehensive exploration program for lithium associated with pegmatites within the Company's tenements in Broken Hill.

Commenting on the result, Silver City Managing Director Chris Torrey said: "The support we received from the market puts the Company in a strong financial position to reach its next phase of growth. We are fortunate that Silver City has both zinc and lithium projects as the two commodities are in hot demand. Having the capital to quickly pursue these opportunities will ensure that we can best capitalise on this global trend. The Board would like to thank those eligible shareholders that took up the offer under the SPP and to all shareholders for their continuing support."

Silver City Minerals Limited (SCI) is a base and precious metal explorer with a strong focus on the Broken Hill District of western New South Wales, Australia. It takes its name from the famous Silver City of Broken Hill, home of the world's largest accumulation of silver, lead and zinc; the Broken Hill Deposit. SCI was established in May 2008 and has been exploring the District where it controls Exploration Licences through 100% ownership and various joint venture agreements. It has a portfolio of highly prospective projects with drill-ready targets focused on high grade silver, gold and base-metals, and a pipeline of prospects moving toward the drill assessment stage. The Company continues to seek out quality projects for exploration and development.
