WANGLE READY FOR LAUNCH AFTER SATISFYING **GOVERNMENT REQUIREMENTS**

- Further key performance improvements observed as the Apps build is finalised with Equinix and Wangle partners.
- New results on data savings and speed of internet will be published as they come to hand.
- All testing has been carried out across both Android and iOS ahead of the Apps launch on or before June 15th.
- Opportunities to reduce App operating costs with our partners identified and now built
- The Australian Communications Access Coordinator (CAC) has approved Wangle's interception law exemption.
- This is a significant milestone for the Company and provides a clear path to monetisation.
- Wangle is now clear to launch the Apple iOS and Android versions of its App in Australia and New Zealand.
- The data interception capability plan is well underway with lodgement to the CAC this month.
- Plans are well advanced to expand into additional attractive markets.
- Regulatory approval from the CAC will cement Wangle's early mover advantage in the VPN space in Australia and will facilitate the roll out elsewhere.
- Pre-registration for the Apple iOS and Google Android versions of its App commenced on 1 May 2016.

Wangle Technologies Limited (ASX:WGL) (Wangle or the Company) is pleased to announce that it has been granted a temporary Interception Capability Exemption from the Communications Access Coordinator (CAC). This paves the way for the Company to proceed with the public launch of the Wangle App.


The exemption provides Wangle with a 6 month timeframe in which to lodge and implement an Interception plan and in the meantime the Company can proceed with the commercial launch.

Public launch

Users can now pre-register to download the App at www.wan.gl.

The commercial launch of the App in Australia and New Zealand is scheduled for on or before the 15th of June 2016, subject to App Store review (iOS version only), where members of the public will be able to download and use Wangle's revolutionary data optimisation service through Apple's App Store and Google Play Store.

Further updates regarding the public launch will be made as the time approaches.





Interception Capability Exemption

Due to the nature of Wangle's technology the Federal Government has classified Wangle as a "carriage service provider". This means the Company has to comply with the Telecommunications (Interception and Access) Act 1979 (TIA Act).

Wangle may apply for a second temporary exemption if required.

"The commercial launch of the App is imminent now that we have obtained the necessary approval from the CAC. The experience we've gained from addressing regulatory compliance gives us another important edge as Wangle will be one of the first in Australia to meet the new data interception and retention laws," said Wangle's Chief Executive Officer, Jason Gitmans.

What's more, we anticipate that our launch in other countries will be expedited now that we have the framework in place. Having this first mover advantage significantly increases the probability of Wangle becoming a market leader in the industry."
