A selection of highlights from the interview are as follows:

- Operations have increased during the FY16
  - o Doubled patient numbers on the platform
  - o Pharmacy market share increased from 20% to 30%

"The addressable market is significant with 50% of Australians with a chronic disease. For people to look after and manage medications has to date been a very manual process, much like the banking process used to be. Today, we wouldn't dream of having to visit a branch to view our bank balance.

"One of the important focuses for us is to connect more patients to the platform and to realise the multiple revenue streams that can be generated from this. The recently announced acquisition of Healthnotes takes us 12 months ahead in our land-grab initiative, taking us to over 500,000 patients and a nearly 45% share of the pharmacy market." - Robert Read, CEO, MedAdvisor.
