VOTING EXCLUSION

The Company will disregard any votes cast in favour of Resolution 1, by the Chairman, any director of the Company and their associates. However, the Company will not disregard a vote if it is cast by an above-mentioned person:

- (a) who votes in accordance with the directions on the proxy form, or
- (b) if it is cast by that person chairing the meeting as proxy for a person who is entitled to vote, in accordance with a direction on the proxy form to vote as the proxy decides.

2. Resolution 1

Article 20.1(a) of the Articles of Association requires that directors' fees be determined by the Company in general meeting. If this resolution is approved, the amount of directors' fees payable to each director shall be determined by and among themselves.

3. Resolution 2

Article 18.5 of the Articles of Association provides, inter alia, that a director who is appointed a director by other directors, either to fill a casual vacancy or as an additional director, holds office only until the next following annual general meeting and shall be eligible to seek re-election.

ZHANG Houyi was appointed a director by the board on 1 August 2022. Therefore, in accordance with Article 18.5 of the Articles of Association, ZHANG Houyi, being eligible, offers himself for re-election as a director. If re-elected, ZHANG Houyi will continue to act as the Company's managing director and, in accordance with the Company's Articles of Association, he is not subject to re-election by rotation.

4. Resolution 3

Article 18.5 of the Articles of Association provides, inter alia, that a director who is appointed a director by other directors, either to fill a casual vacancy or as an additional director, holds office only until the next following annual general meeting and shall be eligible to seek re-election.

LAM Longhuy was appointed a director by the board on 1 August 2022. Therefore, in accordance with Article 18.5 of the Articles of Association, LAM Longhuy, being eligible, offers himself for re-election as a director. If re-elected, LAM Longhuy will continue to act as the Company's independent director.

5. Resolution 4

Article 18.5 of the Articles of Association provides, inter alia, that a director who is appointed a director by other directors, either to fill a casual vacancy or as an additional director, holds office only until the next following annual general meeting and shall be eligible to seek re-election.

Ilmars DRAUDINS was appointed a director by the board on 1 August 2022. Therefore, in accordance with Article 18.5 of the Articles of Association, Ilmars DRAUDINS, being eligible, offers himself for re-election as a director. If re-elected, Ilmars DRAUDINS will continue to act as the Company's independent director.

6. Resolution 5

Article 18.5 of the Articles of Association provides, inter alia, that a director who is appointed a director by other directors, either to fill a casual vacancy or as an additional director, holds office only until the next following annual general meeting and shall be eligible to seek re-election.

PENG Fali was appointed a director by the board on 9 September 2023. Therefore, in accordance with Article 18.5 of the Articles of Association, PENG Fali, being eligible, offers herself for re-election as a director. If re-elected, PENG Fali will continue to act as the Company's independent director.

7. Resolution 6

Article 35.1(c) of the Articles of Association requires that the Company, at every annual general meeting, appoint an auditor to hold office until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting. Ho Associates, Chartered Accountants, who hold office as auditor immediately before the annual general meeting, have expressed their willingness to be reappointed auditors of the Company.

RIGHT TO APPOINT PROXIES

A shareholder is entitled to attend the meeting either in person or by proxy. The Articles of Association requires that:

(1) the instrument appointing a proxy (Proxy Form) must be in writing and signed by the

- appointor or the appointor's attorney duly authorised in writing, or, if the appointor is a body corporate, by its corporate representative or at least two of its officers, and
- (2) the Proxy Form must be received by the Company at least forty-eight hours before the meeting by delivery to the Company's office, by facsimile received at the Company's office or at any other place, fax number or electronic address specified for the purpose in the notice of meeting.
