## Orion Health signs new contract with U.S. health information exchange

Orion Health (OHE:NZX/ASX) announced today it has signed a new expanded agreement with Keystone Health Information Exchange (KeyHIE) in Pennsylvania. KeyHIE is an existing customer that currently uses Orion Health's platform to enable information to be shared between healthcare providers.
