Z Energy quarterly operating update

Reported industry volumes flat

During the quarter Z's terminal operations staff reported that Mobil had ceased to supply Gull at its Mt Maunganui terminal and that Gull was now being supplied by its parent company. As this supply agreement is not captured through Industry Exchange, Gull volumes are no longer being reported in the data.

The total industry volume for all fuels as reported through Industry Exchange data was flat (-0.2%) year on year at 2,441 million litres but due to the change in supply arrangements as noted above saw a sequential decline from the December quarter.

The decline in reported retail volume was offset by commercial volume, with 'Other fuels' increasing in Bitumen, Marine and Jet due to changing schedules in the Cruise Line market and seasonal adjustments to schedules out of Auckland International Airport.

Z network retail petrol volume increased year on year for the quarter reflecting the addition of the Foodstuffs retail outlets. Caltex network retail volume declined year on year but remained flat on a sequential basis, the result of additional marketing activity across the network.

Due to Gull's small market share in Diesel, changes to Industry Exchange reporting does not materially affect the data. Diesel, for both networks and for retail and commercial, was flat on both a year on year and sequential basis.

Average store sales

Weekly average store sales for the Z network increased on an absolute and like for like basis to \$39,039 reflecting the company's network optimization work and focus on Customer Experience. Z retail customer satisfaction remains high at 91%.

Confirming FY19 guidance and full year results presentation

Z reaffirms FY19 earnings guidance for EBITDAF to be in a range of \$420 million - \$450 million and dividend on a cents per share basis to between \$0.38 and \$0.47 per share.

Z will release it is full year earnings on Thursday, 2 May at 8.30am (NZT).
