

#### **Gross Debt to Revenue Ratio**






# Funding Approach & Debt Market Activity

### Funding Diversity (as at 30 June 2019)

- Gross debt of NZ\$9.0 billion
- Multiple offshore issues (2 prior benchmark Euro issues)
- Weighted average term of 5.4 years
- Funding via LGFA\* = 25% of their lending (capped at 40%)
- Backed by NZ\$1.3 billion standby facility
- Green bond issuance




Auckland Council Group funding mix



#### NZ\$ millions




