### Z Energy introduction of weekly volume data

In response to requests for greater clarity around current fuel market trading conditions during the COVID-19 pandemic, Z Energy (NZX:ZEL) has decided to provide weekly volume data to investors and other interested parties.

Data will include retail volumes for the Z network including Foodstuffs, the Caltex network and for the domestic supply arrangements that Z supports. The data will include all fuel volumes for the week up to 11.59pm the prior Sunday.

Z will also disclose commercial volume data, specifically Truckstop volume including private Truckstops that Z supplies to our large commercial customers and Mini-Tankers. We will also provide Commercial Jet and Marine volume.

Volume data will be disclosed to the NZX on Thursday the 9<sup>th</sup> of April, and then every following Wednesday. Z Energy will not provide any commentary about retail margins or convenience store sales.
