Z Energy weekly volume data

In response to requests for greater clarity around current market trading conditions Z Energy (NZX:ZEL) is providing weekly volume data during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Data includes retail volumes for the Z network including Foodstuffs, the Caltex network and for the domestic supply arrangements that Z supports. The data includes all fuel volumes for the prior week up to 11.59pm on Sunday.

Z is also disclosing commercial volume data, specifically Truckstop volumes including private Truckstops that Z supplies to our large commercial customers and Mini-Tankers. We are also providing Commercial Jet, Marine and 'Other' volumes.

Z Energy will not provide any commentary about retail margins or convenience store sales until the release of our full year FY20 results.
