Z Energy weekly volume data

In response to requests for greater clarity around current market trading conditions Z Energy (NZX:ZEL ASX:ZEL) (Z) is providing weekly volume data during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Data includes retail volumes for the Z network including Foodstuffs, the Caltex network and for the domestic supply arrangements that Z supports. The data includes all fuel volumes for the prior week up to 11.59pm on Sunday.

Z is also disclosing commercial volume data, specifically Truckstop volumes including private Truckstops that Z supplies to our large commercial customers and Mini-Tankers. We are also providing Commercial Jet, Marine and 'Other' volumes.

Volumes for the week ended 24 May 2020 have increased with a full week in national level 2 lockdown. Volumes increased by \sim 9% compared to the prior week and \sim 25% from the week ended the 10 May 2020, the last full week of level 3 lockdown. Volumes for the week are down \sim 27% (\sim 17% excluding Jet) compared to volumes observed in pre-lockdown levels.⁵
