Z Energy weekly volume data

In response to requests for greater clarity around current market trading conditions Z Energy (NZX:ZEL ASX:ZEL) (Z) is providing weekly volume data during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Data includes retail volumes for the Z network including Foodstuffs, the Caltex network and for the domestic supply arrangements that Z supports. The data includes all fuel volumes for the prior week up to 11.59pm on Sunday.

Z is also disclosing commercial volume data, specifically Truckstop volumes including private Truckstops that Z supplies to our large commercial customers and Mini-Tankers. We are also providing Commercial Jet, Marine and 'Other' volumes.

Total volume for the week ended 14 June 2020 increased by \sim 5% compared to the prior week, with Retail, Truckstops, and 'Other domestic retail supply' increasing materially, slightly offset by a decrease in 'Other commercial fuels'. Volumes for the week are down \sim 26% (\sim 16% excluding Jet) compared to pre-lockdown levels.⁵
