Results of Spark New Zealand Limited Annual Meeting of Shareholders

At Spark's annual shareholder meeting, held virtually today, shareholders were asked to vote on three resolutions, which were supported by the Board.

As required by NZX Listing Rule 6.1, all voting was conducted by a poll.

The resolutions passed by shareholders were:

- That the directors of Spark are authorised to fix the auditor's remuneration.
- That Ms Alison Barrass, who retires by rotation and is eligible for re-election, is reelected as a director of Spark.
- That Mr David Havercroft, who retires by rotation and is eligible for re-election, is reelected as a director of Spark.
