



IAG announces the Margin on Capital Notes 2 and increases the Offer size following the completion of the Bookbuild

Insurance Australia Group Limited (IAG) today announced that it has successfully completed the Bookbuild for the offer of Capital Notes 2 (Offer) announced on 21 November 2022.

IAG has allocated \$500 million of Capital Notes 2 under the New Money Offer and Reinvestment Offer and the Margin has been set at 3.50% per annum. Due to strong demand, the Offer size was increased from the \$400 million IAG announced in the Offer launch announcement on 21 November 2022.

A replacement Prospectus containing the Margin and revised Offer size is expected to be lodged with ASIC and the ASX on 29 November 2022. The replacement Prospectus will be available online via the Offer website at www.iag.com.au.

Eligible investors should speak to their Syndicate Broker to make an Application once the Offer opens on 29 November 2022.

The Offer is expected to close at 5:00pm (Sydney time) on 15 December 2022.

Applications must be made through a Syndicate Broker and there is no ability to apply directly to IAG. Eligible investors should read the replacement Prospectus and the Capital Notes 2 Terms in full before deciding to invest.

Unless otherwise specified, capitalised terms in this announcement have the meaning given to them in the Prospectus.
