## BID COSTS RELATING TO NEW INTERCITY FLEET

Downer EDI Limited (Downer) announced today that the Constellation Rail consortium had not been successful in its bid to deliver and maintain the New Intercity Fleet for Transport for NSW.

Constellation Rail consists of Downer and CRRC Changchun Railway Vehicles Co Ltd.

Downer's share of pre-tax bid costs totalled \$10 million (\$7 million after tax) and will now be expensed.

Downer announced on 4 August 2016 that it was targeting net profit after tax (NPAT) of around \$170 million for the 2017 financial year.

As a consequence of expensing the bid costs associated with the New Intercity Fleet, Downer's NPAT target for the 2017 financial year is now \$163 million.
