ATOMIC APPOINTS ENERGY CONSULTANT TO NGAKA COAL PROJECT BFS TEAM

Atomic Resources Limited (ASX Code: ATQ) ("Atomic") is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Todd Eggar to act as a senior energy consultant to Atomic's Bankable Feasibility Study (BFS) team with responsibility for power generation, power transmission and power station development.

Atomic is working closely with the Tanzanian government and power entities to facilitate and to develop a 3Mtpa thermal coal mining operation at Ngaka in Southern Tanzania providing feed stock to an on-site 400 Mw IGCC "clean coal" power plant, which will be developed in conjunction with the Tanzanian Government. Atomic seeks to also earn an equity position in the power station through funding and managing the feasibility study, which has the potential to provide an additional revenue stream for the Company, once the power station becomes operational.

Atomic Resources Managing Director Dave Holden said, "Todd Eggar is a highly experienced and qualified energy consultant. He will be a leading figure in Atomic's team of consultants preparing the BFS into the development of the Ngaka power station."

Todd is a Project Development Specialist holding a B.Sc. in Chemistry and a B.Eng. in Electrical and Control Systems Engineering from the University of Saskatchewan as well as an MBA with a finance specialization from Athabasca University. Currently based in Tanzania, Todd has been

involved in similar power projects in the Asia/ Pacific, Latin America, Central West Africa, the United States and in his native Canada.

To provide incentive, Mr. Eggar will be awarded 200,000 options at \$0.25 exercise price, and 200,000 options at \$0.35 exercise price for a two year term to help successfully develop the power company.
