## **Heads of Agreement to Expire**

Australian energy company Eneabba Gas Limited (ASX: ENB) ("the Company") advises that it has today advised Carbon Energy Limited that it does not propose to extend the term of the Heads of Agreement, which is currently due to expire on 18 December 2009, with Carbon Energy in regards its coal resources being acquired by Carbon Energy Limited.

With an assessment of its 2010 exploration programme and initial JORC results for one coal area of the Sargon tenements by an independent resource specialist, the Company has decided to totally review its strategy on all matters and will focus on maximising income and in-house technical management. This will include UCG operations, gas transmission and fuel delivery to the Centauri 1 Power Station and its GE LM 6000 gas-fired turbines.
