MAp REPORTS ON TRAFFIC PERFORMANCE AT ITS AIRPORTS FOR JUNE 2009

Macquarie Airports (MAp) today released its monthly report on traffic performance at its airports for June 2009.

MAp Chief Executive Officer, Ms Kerrie Mather, said, "The traffic performance at MAp's airports in June shows continued evidence of moderation in the rates of decline, with Copenhagen and Brussels in particular displaying single digit falls. European Summer capacity has clearly rebounded from the lows of the first quarter of the year.

"Despite the difficult external environment, it is pleasing that our airline marketing efforts are continuing to result in our airports winning new routes and services. Tiger Airways and Delta Airlines commenced operations from Sydney in early July and Tiger have already announced a significant expansion in their Sydney presence when they receive their next aircraft in October.

At Copenhagen, easyJet announced a new route to Manchester from the Northern Autumn which will mean that easyJet will have more than doubled its services out of Copenhagen in just one year. At Brussels too, easyJet is increasing frequencies and there is some restoration of Brussels Airlines short haul capacity," Ms Mather added.

Sydney Airport

Key Points:

- Total passenger traffic for June is estimated to have decreased 4.1% on the pcp with domestic traffic estimated to be down 3.8% on the pcp and international traffic (excluding domestic on-carriage) down 4.0% on the pcp.
- The USA was the major market which grew (+14%) together with traveller growth from Canada (+3%) and France (+16%). Australia (-5%), the UK (-2%), New Zealand (-3%), Japan (-47%), Korea (-25%), China (-2%), India (-10%) and Germany (-5%) were the major markets that declined.
- Tiger Airways, which commenced services from Sydney on 3 July, has announced a significant expansion in its schedules from 4 October. It will fly up to 9 times daily between Sydney and Melbourne and double daily between Sydney and Adelaide.

Copenhagen Airport

Key Points

- June traffic was 8.7% lower than the pcp, with O&D traffic down 5.8%.
- Domestic traffic was flat on the pcp and international traffic decreased 6.4%.
- Domestic traffic performance has improved due to increased competition on the route to Aalborg which is now served by three airlines.
- The decline in O&D traffic has moderated compared to recent months as a result of new low cost airline capacity replacing the lost Sterling services. The decline in transfer traffic is largely associated with SAS capacity reductions
- easyJet announced a new route from Copenhagen to Manchester to open in the Autumn, more than doubling the number of its services out of Copenhagen in just one year. The route will have six weekly frequencies.
- easyJet also announced that it will operate four weekly flights to Geneva from December 2009.

Brussels Airport

Key Points

- Total traffic for June was 9.1% lower than the pcp, continuing the moderation in decline when compared to previous months.
- Extra-EU traffic was 4.6% lower than the pcp, benefitting from Etihad increasing frequencies compared to previous months.
- Intra-EU traffic was 11.4% lower than the pcp, a month-on-month improvement driven by Brussels Airlines gradually restoring capacity and increased easyJet frequencies.

Bristol Airport

Key Points

- Overall traffic for June was 11.9% lower than the pcp.
- Domestic traffic was 7.6% lower than the pcp. This was primarily due to reduced flights from easyJet and Air Southwest, partially offset by the new Ryanair service to Belfast City.
- International traffic decreased 10.1%, predominantly due to reduced easyJet and Ryanair frequencies and the suspension of Lufthansa's Frankfurt service.
- Charter traffic was 19.2% down on the pcp due to the ongoing impact of the loss of XL Airways and a reduction in ad-hoc charter traffic.
