Drilling Update – Edirne, Western Turkey

Otto Energy (ASX: OEL) (**Otto** or **Company**) advises that the field operator Petroleum Exploration Mediterranean Int. Pty Ltd (**PEMI**), has advised that the Kirmizihoyuk exploration well located in the Edirne Licence, onshore Western Turkey was spudded on 12 May 2009.

The Kirmizihoyuk-1 well is located 4km NNW of the Bati-Umur 1 discovery drilled in 2008. The planned total depth of the well is 450 metres and is expected to take approximately 12 days to drill. Kirmizihoyuk-1 targets P50 prospective gas resources of approximately 0.75bcf within the Osmancik formation.

Six gas discoveries have been made to date on the Edirne Licence with a number of prospective leads having been identified on 3D seismic, including the Kirmizihoyuk prospect.

Otto holds a 35 per cent interest in the Edirne Licence. The Edirne Licence is operated by joint venture partners PEMI (55%) and Petraco (10%).

The Company will update the market on drill results once the well reaches total depth.
