FIRST ORE DELIVERED TO DENISON'S WHITE MESA URANIUM MILL, UTAH

US-focussed uranium producer White Canyon Uranium Limited (**ASX: WCU**) ("White Canyon" or "the Company") is pleased to announce that first ore has now been delivered to the White Mesa Mill owned by Denison Mines Corp. (TSX: DML; NYSE AMEX: DNN).

"This is another significant milestone for the Company which has progressed from uranium explorer to become the first new producer of uranium in Utah, USA. This has occurred in just 22 months after listing on the ASX. It is an extraordinary achievement, one which many companies take several years to realise, and it is a tribute to the strength and dedication of our mining team led by Operations Director Kelly Shumway." "I expect 2010 will be a very good year for White Canyon now that production is in place" Managing Director Peter Batten said.

In October 2009 the Company announced that trucking of ore to Denison's White Mesa Mill, some 100 kilometres by road from the Daneros mine, would commence in December 2009 and that proceeds from its sale of first ore to Denison were scheduled to be received in January 2010".

"I am pleased to say that we are on track to receive first sale proceeds in January 2010 as planned" he said.

White Canyon is the newest uranium producer in Utah, USA. The Company listed on the ASX listed in March 2008 as an advanced uranium exploration company holding a 100% interest in the advanced Thompson, Daneros, Lark Royal, Geitus, Blue Jay and Marcy Look Projects in south-east Utah. These projects comprise over 12,000 acres of mining claims and mineral leases. Since listing on the ASX the Company has doubled its landholdings. The Company's projects contain historically defined high grade uranium deposits, however the deposits are not JORC compliant. White Canyon entered the ranks of uranium producers in December 2009 with first production from the Daneros mine.

Denison is a diversified, growth oriented, intermediate uranium producer with three active mines in the United States, and others on stand-by in Canada and the US. The assets of Denison also include an interest in two of the four licensed and operating conventional uranium mills in North America, with its 100% ownership of the White Mesa mill in Utah and its 22.5% ownership of the McClean Lake mill in Saskatchewen. Both mills are fully permitted and operating, with Denison's 2008 production from the two mills being approximately 1.6 million pounds of U_3O_8 and 1.2 million pounds of vanadium.
