Government Grant Payment


Australian Wave Energy developer, Carnegie Wave Energy Limited (ASX: CWE), is pleased to advise that it has received its second milestone payment under its \$12.5 million grant from the State Government of Western Australian.

The \$847,933 milestone payment under the financial assistance agreement is for the completion of activities associated with subsea foundation deployment, design and manufacturing, and site assessment and development for Carnegie's Perth Wave Energy Project. Carnegie has now drawn down approximately \$1.6m of the \$12.5 million grant and is currently meeting all development milestones.

About CETO

The CETO system distinguishes itself from other wave energy devices by operating out of sight and being anchored to the ocean floor. An array of submerged buoys is tethered to seabed pump units. The buoys move in harmony with the motion of the passing waves, driving the pumps which in turn pressurise water that is delivered ashore via a pipeline.

High-pressure water is used to drive hydroelectric turbines, generating zero-emission electricity. The high-pressure water can also be used to supply a reverse osmosis desalination plant, replacing greenhouse gas emitting electrically driven pumps usually required for such plants.
