Placement to Asian based Corporation, Australian Institutions and Sophisticated Investors

The Board of Hemisphere Resources Ltd (AS: HEM) is pleased to announce that it has placed 6.8 million shares at 70 cents with an Asian based corporation. The parties associated with the placement have advised that they have reviewed a number of opportunities within the Australian resources sector and have determined their preference to invest in Hemisphere Resources Ltd.

Additionally, and in an effort to bolster institutional shareholder support within the Hemisphere Resources Ltd share register, the Board is also pleased to announce that it has placed a further 2.2 million shares at 70 cents per share, to Australian based institutions and sophisticated investors.


