Tiwi Islands

The start-up of mining at Lethbridge will commence in early June. Late rains in March and April have caused the start-up to be delayed by several weeks.

All major contracts for the Lethbridge project have been signed and preparations are progressing for moving the camp and processing plant.

Our mining contractors Brash Contracting have started upgrading roads post the end of the quarter in April ready for the relocation of the camp and processing plant.

The construction of the screening and slurry unit will be completed in April and will be transported to Lethbridge in May ready for the start of mining at Lethbridge West.

Construction has commenced on the Pre-concentrator and it is planned to be delivered to Lethbridge in August prior to mining commencing at Lethbridge South.

The commercial agreement with Tricoastal will underpin the Tiwi development with Tricoastal taking all the concentrate produced and supplying working capital through their US\$2 million loan and subscribing for US\$500,000 of shares.

Drilling is planned for the One Tree Point deposit on Bathurst Island next quarter. Previous limited drilling at One Tree Point identified a significant dunal deposit which could potentially provide 2-3 years mining after Lethbridge.

Keysbrook

Prior to commencing mining at Keysbrook Matilda must obtain Development Approvals and Extractive Industry Licences from the two shires in which the Keysbrook orebody is situated.

Applications have been made to both shires and we expect their determinations in the next quarter.
