






- Six tenements in central Bowen Basin, two granted, four applications pending

## Comet Project – EPC 1230




#### **Open Pit Coking Coal Target**

- Situated on the Comet Dome, surrounded by existing coal operations
- Burngrove Formation in south-west sector
  - Along strike from Stanmore Coal's McKenzie River Project coking coal resource
  - Principal target is equivalent to Aries Seam

#### Fair Hill Formation

- Historical drilling has intersected 6m coal at surface,
  9.9 metres at 53 metres
- Substantial resource potential
- Cladstone cross the tenement
- Initial drilling program expected to commence in December 2010




### Cullin La Ringo – EPCA 1720



#### **Targeting Export Thermal Coals**

- Multiple targets developed
- Shallow target in the sub-cropping Burngrove and Fair Hill Formation on the eastern margin
- Coking coal possible at shallow depth within German Creek Coal Measure equivalents
- Deeper Reids Dome sequence (Minerva and Cullin la Ringo coal deposits) is a significant target on the western portion
- Up to eight seams of export quality thermal coal may exist in the tenement area
- Analysis of existing seismic and petroleum wells underway




### Emerald Project - EPC 1580 & EPCA 1801



#### **Export thermal coal target**

- Two substantial targets
- Historical drilling and seismic shows Rangal Coal Measures under the central and eastern areas
  - Potential shallow target
- Multi-seam Minerva Mine sequence (Reids Dome) is long term target in the SW area
- Coal quality similar to Ensham and Minerva export products (high volatile, low ash, low sulphur)
- Excellent infrastructure with existing rail line traversing the tenement
  - Distance to the nearest port (Gladstone) is 340 kilometres




### Spring Creek – EPCA 1505



#### **Low Ash Thermal Coal Target**

- Springsure Shelf, an emerging new coal province
- Immediately south of MacArthur Coal's Buckland coal deposit – defined resource of 80Mt open cut thermal coal
- Thost is Bandanna Formation (Rangal) west of the Merivale Fault
- Buckland coal sequence (4 seams) dips south directly into Spring Creek
- Coal quality similar to Rolleston export thermal coal.
  - A raw coal blend appears ideally suited to domestic power
  - Washed B, C, and D seam product suitable for export.




#### Jack Creek - EPCA 1319



#### **Long Term Potential**

- Located southeast of Rolleston Mine (Xstrata)
- Historic gas exploration wells in the area confirm the presence of the Bandanna Coal Measures (Rangal) at depth across the entire tenement
- Known seam characteristics
- Long term objective is to explore avenues to extract contained energy


