CLEM7 TRAFFIC VOLUMES - FIRST WEEK TOLLED

RiverCity Motorway Group today announced traffic volumes for the first week following the commencement of tolling on the Clem Jones Tunnel (CLEM7).

The 7-day period is from Tuesday, 6 April 2010 to Monday, 12 April 2010. There were five workdays in the period, which also corresponded with the Queensland school holidays.

RiverCity Motorway Group CEO, Flan Cleary, said it was still too early to judge the success or otherwise of the CLEM7.

“The opening of the CLEM7 represents a major change Brisbane motorists, therefore, it may take some months for travel patterns to become apparent,” he said.

Until 9 May 2010, the CLEM7 will remain toll-free between the hours of midnight and 5.00am. For the remainder of the day, tolls for all motorists will be discounted by 30%.
