## **CLEM7 TRAFFIC VOLUMES – JUNE 2010**

RiverCity Motorway Group today announced traffic volumes for June 2010 on the Clem Jones Tunnel (CLEM7).

## **Key points:**

- Average Daily Trips of 22,545 was 5.2% higher than May 2010.
- Average Workday Trips was 25,192, an increase of 6.1% compared to May 2010.
- The highest number of trips on a single workday during the month was 27,666 trips.
- Light Commercial Vehicles comprised 13% of vehicles that used the CLEM7 during the period.

The original forecast was for 60,451 Average Daily Trips one month after opening (assuming the full toll was charged), scheduled to increase by approximately 33% over the first two months. Actual traffic levels of 22,545 Average Daily Trips in June 2010 is well below the original forecast, as is the traffic growth rate of 6.5% over the first two months.
