CLEM7 TRAFFIC VOLUMES – SEPTEMBER 2010

RiverCity Motorway Group today announced traffic volumes for September 2010 on the Clem Jones Tunnel (CLEM7).

Key points:

- Average Daily Trips of 28,419 was 1.28% higher than August 2010.
- Average Workday Trips was 31,238 a decrease of 1.07% compared to August 2010.
- The Queensland School Holiday period was from 20 September 2010 to 1 October 2010.
- The northbound tunnel was closed from 10:00pm to 5:00am over 4 days during the period for scheduled maintenance. The southbound tunnel was closed from 10:00pm to 5:00am over 5 days during the period for scheduled maintenance and a simulated emergency exercise inside the tunnel.
- The highest number of trips on a single workday during the month was 33,810 trips, which occurred on Friday, 3 September 2010.
- Light Commercial Vehicles comprised 11.6% of vehicles that used the CLEM7 during the period.
