WESTMINSTER GOLD PROJECT- DRILLING PROGRAM STATUS

Drilling completed to date at the Westminster Project continues to confirm the predicted controls on mineralisation within a defined shear/alteration zone.

The first 1,840m of the current drilling program targeted shallow (<150m) mineralisation in the upper mineralised pods within the shear zone. Assay results are anticipated early in the new-year.

Several RC pre-collars have also been completed to facilitate follow up deeper drilling with diamond core tails. These deeper holes target extensions to the gold rich magnetite chlorite intersected by previous drilling.

Drilling has been temporarily suspended for the Christmas period. Drilling will be accelerated in the new-year with addition of a second drill rig. Both rigs are contracted to re-commence drilling from the 10th January2011.
