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## **ADDITIONAL GOLD INTERSECTIONS AT GLANDORE**

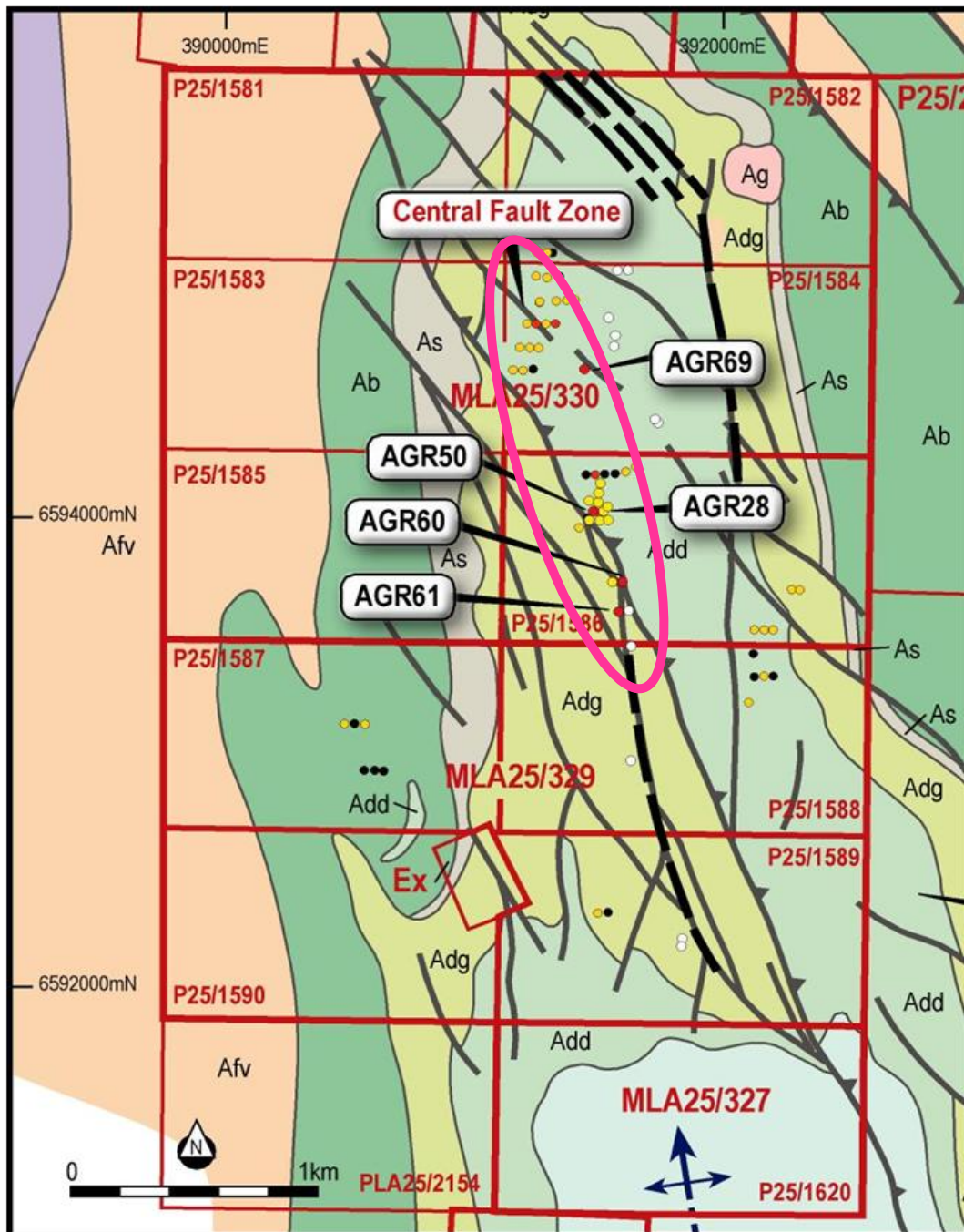


Figure 1 Drilling results (Yellow  $>0.1$ g/t and Red  $>1$ g/t). The strongly mineralised portion of Central Fault Zone is shown in the Magenta ellipse.

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The Directors of **Aruma Resources Limited (Aruma) (ASX:AAJ)** are pleased to announce that the Company has successfully completed its follow up drilling programme at its flagship Glandore Project, located 40km East of Kalgoorlie-Boulder. A total of 26 holes (AGR49 to 74) were drilled to further test selected gold anomalies including GRC 28. Of particular interest was the Central Fault Zone as shown in Figure 1 below.

A total of 74 holes (AGR1 to 74) have now been drilled to test gold anomalies in areas previously underexplored or unexplored. Some three quarters of the holes drilled and assayed to date (46 of 62 holes) encountered anomalous gold mineralisation.

Previously reported drill hole AGR 28 contained an 11 m intersection at 2.32 g/t from 1m and subsequent holes to date included AGR50 intersected 1m at 1.07g/t from 15m south of AGR28. AGR 60 intersected 4m @1.4 from 11, AGR 61 intersected 6m @1.26 from 30 and AGR 69 intersected 2m at 4.77 g/t along the Central Fault Zone Location.

The majority of holes from the second program assayed to date (16 out of 17) have intersected anomalous gold values ( $\geq 0.1$  g/t) and in the 16 holes there were 95 values with an average 0.47 g/t Au. This 2 km long anomaly (Magenta Ellipse in Figure 1 below) will be evaluated with 3D modelling as soon as the remainder of the assays are received.

Further assay results are still to be received which will be reported when available.

Two Agreements have been negotiated with the traditional owner groups to enable the granting of 3 mining licences over the main gold mineralisation area at Glandore. The company sees this as the start of a beneficial partnership in future production from the area.

### Regional Projects

The innovative Hyvista Mineral Mapping method has been used on all of the Projects. Initial studies have identified the alteration associated with gold (Goethite-Mica-Carbonate) in previously explored areas at Gindalbie and Glandore, with similar alteration evident in all the areas studied.

Strong anomalies have been noted on all properties and targets are being identified and ranked by the Hyvista Corporation with input from the Aruma Exploration team. These will be investigated by soil and auger sampling in the next quarter.

### Tenement Acquisition

A 60km<sup>2</sup> prospective Exploration Licence has now been applied for at Gindalbie and will be explored when granted. Several smaller ELs have been applied for near Steeple Hill as part of the Company's land acquisition strategy. This strategy has seen the land holding grow 235 km<sup>2</sup> in the last six months since listing. This has been done in a competitive arena by a mixture of applications and outright purchases.
