In the financial year ended 30 June 2011, the Company issued a convertible bond to secure additional funding of A\$ 7,412,000, which is intended to be applied in the continued development of the developing business. Under the terms of the bond, the Company granted to the bond holder options to subscribe for 21,800,000 of its shares at A\$ 0.40 per share and an expiry of 2 years after issue. Additionally, the bond holder is also granted an option to subscribe for Cordlife Singapore shares at no additional consideration.

The bond agreement contains a default clause that requires the Company to maintain A\$ 7,412,000 in its cash balance until such time as the options granted to the bond holder are exercised. On this basis, the A\$ 7,412,000 received had been classified as restricted cash, and not as part of cash and cash equivalents.
