REQUEST FOR TRADING HALT

In accordance with Listing Rule 17.1, Coffey International Limited (**Coffey**) requests that an immediate trading halt be placed on its securities.

Set out below is the information required by Listing Rule 17.1:


- a) The reason for the trading halt is that Coffey anticipates making an announcement in relation to the Strategic Portfolio Review currently being performed by its newly appointed Managing Director.

Following the Price Query received from the ASX on 3 June 2011, Coffey has accelerated its review and key stakeholder consultation processes relating to this Strategic Review to enable briefing of the Board and announcement to the market by Wednesday 8 June 2011.

- b) The trading halt is requested until the commencement of trade on Wednesday 8 June 2011 or such earlier time as Coffey makes an announcement to update the market.
- c) Coffey expects to make an announcement to the market concerning this matter before the commencement of trading on Wednesday 8 June 2011.
- d) Coffey is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted.
- e) Coffey is not aware of any other information necessary to inform the market about the trading halt.
