Request for Voluntary Suspension

Further to its request for a trading halt on Thursday, 24 March 2011, iSOFT Group Limited (ASX: ISF) (*Company*), in accordance with Listing Rule 17.2, requests that ASX grant a voluntary suspension of its securities.

The trading halt was requested pending an announcement regarding an update on the Company's strategic review process. The Directors consider that the current status of the strategic review process and the proposals received as part of this process, including relating to a potential change of control, are not sufficiently advanced to permit the disclosure of complete information to the market. Given the nature of proposals received, in the absence of a detailed announcement there is potential for trading to take place in a speculative or uninformed market. Accordingly, the Company requests a voluntary suspension of its securities to prevent trading taking place in a speculative or uninformed market ahead of the announcement.

The Company expects it will be in a position to make an announcement on this matter in the next week and requests that the voluntary suspension remain in place until the commencement of trading on Monday 4 April 2011. The Company will advise the market further as soon as there have been any material developments.

The Company is not aware of any reason why its securities should not be suspended.
