**RUBIANNA RESOURCES AWARDED \$90,000 WA GOVERNMENT DRILLING GRANT**

**Highlights**

- **A \$90,000 Western Australian Government co-funded drilling grant for drilling at the Ruby Well, Quartz Well and Killara Projects awarded to Rubianna.**

**Rubianna Resources Limited** (ASX: **RRE**) is pleased to announce that it has been awarded a \$90,000 Western Australian Government grant to support drilling programmes at its Murchison Project.

The co-funded drilling grant will be utilised to test for depth extensions of the quartz reef horizons, focusing on the Bloodstone prospect, within the Ruby Well Project area and to develop gold and VMS (Volcanogenic Massive Sulphide) targets within the Quartz Well and Killara Projects. It is anticipated that the co-funded drilling will be carried out by November.

The grant was awarded under the Government's "Innovative Drilling Program" within its Exploration Incentive Scheme (EIS). The co-funding is allocated to selected recipients under a competitive grant process to undertake exploration drilling in "Greenfield" areas. Under the EIS programme guidelines Rubianna is required to match the \$90,000 in funding provided by the Government.
