WESTMINSTER GOLD PROJECT- PROGRAM STATUS

The second phase of the Westminster drilling program, commenced on the 10th January 2011, was completed on the 18th February 2011. It is anticipated that results from mineralised sections of the diamond core and subsequent assessment will follow in approximately four weeks.

In the interim an interpretation is being undertaken using the geology and the structural information recorded from the drilling. This will provide a more comprehensive understanding of the framework of the Westminster mineralised system.

As part of the assessment process further drilling is being planned to extend and define zones of potential commercial mineralisation. This drilling program is planned to follow the release of the report on the work to hand. The drilling is expected to be initiated in April 2011.
