EAST LODE DRILLING RESULTS

Underground drilling activity at the Bullant Project continues to test the East Lode. The latest results received are encouraging, and show that mineralisation still occurs. The program was designed to test for strike and lateral extension as well as the continuity of the East Lode ore body. The East Lode is a sub-parallel Lode to Main Lode; it remains relatively untested at depth.




Figure 1: Bullant underground drill locations

The latest addition, to those results already published, are encouraging. The drill spacing is based approximately on a 20m X 20m spacing (refer to *Figure 1*) the further 5 holes received show that economic grade still exists in close proximity to each other (refer to *Table 1*).

The latest intercepts were targeting an area south of the cross fault, an area that was previously remained untested, and on the outer limits of the modelling of the East Lode. These intercepts highlight a positive results showing that consistent grades and widths occur.

Whilst drilling is continuing to complete the current program, additional drilling is being planned to further test extensions of the East Lode.
