Viterra Calls 2012 Annual General and Special Meeting of Shareholders for March 8, 2012 and Updates Shareholders on Continuing Board Renewal Process

Calgary, Alberta – Viterra Inc. ("Viterra" or the "Company") today announced that the 2012 Annual General and Special Meeting of Shareholders will be held on March 8, 2012 at Sheraton Suites Calgary Eau Claire, 255 Barclay Parade S.W., Calgary, Alberta.

Through its Nominating and Corporate Governance Committee, Viterra is in the process of setting a slate of proposed nominees for its Board of Directors that reflects Viterra's commitment to ensure that the evolving needs of the Company are addressed. Vic joined the Board in September 2002 and has helped guide Viterra through its transformation into a leading global agri-business company. Paul, as a former director of ABB Grain Ltd., joined the Board following Viterra's acquisition of ABB Grain in 2009, and his guidance has been invaluable in the successful integration of Viterra and ABB Grain over the last two years."
