JUNDEE SOUTH RESPLITS SHOW HIGH VALUES

Highlights

- High grade gold intersection at Jundee South Gold Prospect
- Twin Hills southern EL29/823 Granted and PoW prepared
- Gindalbie and Glandore PoW ready to be submitted

Growing Western Australian gold explorer, Aruma Resources Limited (ASX: AAJ) is pleased to announce the results of 1m sample splits from a recent drilling program at Jundee South (ASX: 17 January 2012).

Significant anomalous gold intercepts were returned from Aruma's **Jundee South Project** located 60km east of Wiluna on the Jundee-Gourdis-Bronzewing trend in the Wiluna District.

As previously announced, **Jundee South Project** assays defined two carbonate quartz alteration systems with the eastern area over 1.6 km long with mineralisation up to 16m thick. The western area is over 200m long and up to 12m thick. The anomalous intersections included 4m at 2.06 g/t Au in Hole JS22 from 16m, in the 4m composite samples.

The anomalous drilling results were followed up - with the 4m composites re-assayed for 1m splits to better define the mineralisation. This returned 1m samples with assays up to 18.6 g/t Au as well as two 1 g/t Au assays. The results of the 1m samples are shown in table 1 below.

Aruma has now developed three major projects, **Glandore**, **Twin Hills** and **Gindalbie**; and the coming year's exploration program has been designed to prioritise scheduled drilling of these high ranked targets.

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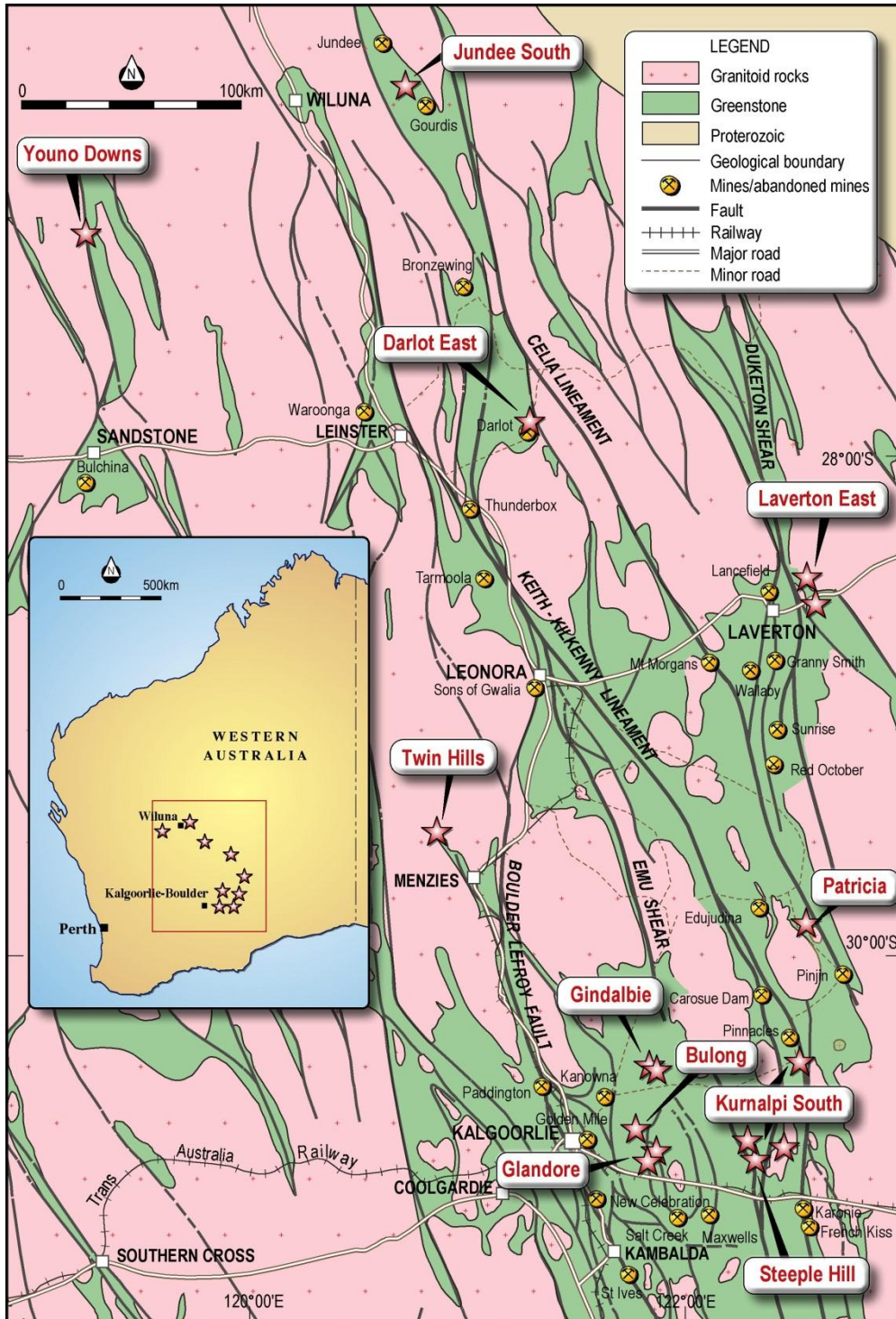


Figure 1 Aruma Resources' project locations

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DISCUSSION OF RESULTS

Jundee South Project

The initial assay results at the Jundee South Project are significant in both extent and tenor. This area was drilled to investigate low level soil anomalies with 0.1 to 0.4 g/t Au values and the results suggest that the western anomaly is a WNW stratigraphic zone; and the eastern, larger anomaly is on a major NNE lineament. Covering two areas some 4 km apart the results indicate that extensive mineralised zones defined by structure and alteration which is completely covered by varying depths (5 to 25m) of tertiary cover. All the intersections showed carbonate (limonitic) alteration in mafics (with iron and silica). These results are the highest grade intersections in the area to date including all the historical results.

An extension to the current PoW has also been applied for to do follow up drilling to fully test the mineralisation extent evident from the geochemistry.

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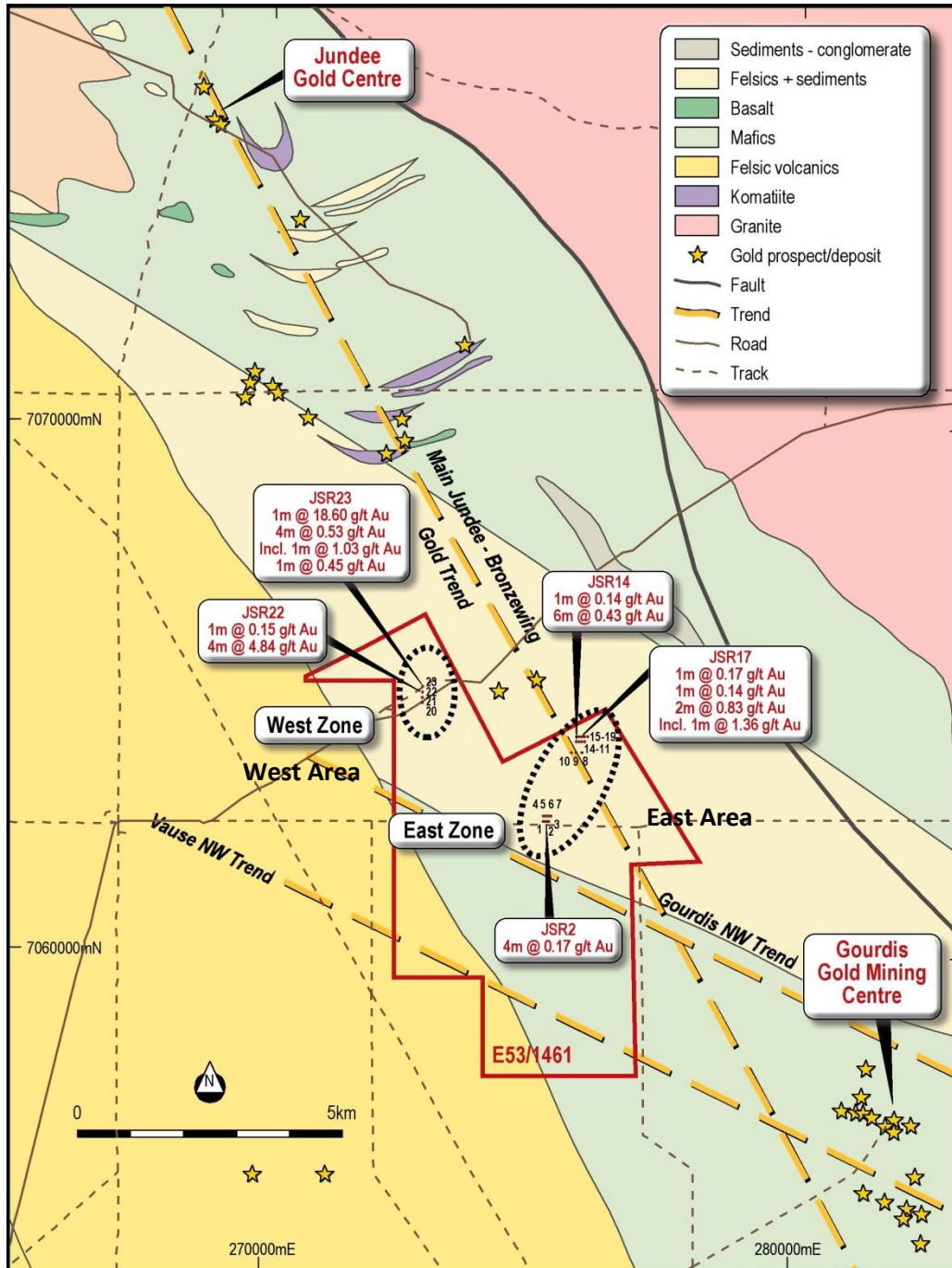


Figure 2 Latest drilling results on the geology at Jundee South showing East and West areas

The locations of the two anomalous zones are shown below in Figure 2 and are represented by the dashed ellipses.

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TWIN HILLS

As previously announced, Aruma has completed an agreement to acquire two new lease areas in WA's prolific eastern Goldfields region, providing an opportunity to acquire: a highly prospective landholding in the Menzies district - an established gold-producing province on the historical gold-producing Moriarty Shear; and mineralised zones adjacent to its own Gindalbie Leases.

The PoW for a first pass drilling campaign has been submitted and site access and drilling is expected to be undertaken this Quarter. The areas to be drilled are fully accessible with cleared drill lines ready for the currently programmed drilling.

The Southern Lease, E29/823, Unfinished Well, was granted in December and the PoW has now been prepared to drill after the northern lease exploration is completed.

The Gindalbie Lease (which was included in the same agreement) has been flown with Hyvista and will be interpreted by Aruma and Hyvista staff in late January. The PoW has been prepared and is to be submitted next week.
