Takeover Offer by Contango MicroCap Limited

On 20th September, Contango MicroCap Limited ("CTN") announced to ASX that it would make an offer to acquire CCQ at \$0.90 cash per share.

The bid by CTN closed on 20 February with CTN having acquired a stake of 74.8% of the Company's shares on issue

Investment Portfolio

At 29 February 2012, listed securities made up 49.5%; unlisted investments were 38.9% and the cash weighting was 11.6% of the investment portfolio.

Unlisted Investments

CCQ owns a 49.9% stake in the manager of its investment portfolio – Contango Asset Management Limited ("CAML"). This NTA calculation values this stake in CAML at \$7.1m which reflects the equity accounted value as at 29 February 2012 which includes CCQ's share of CAML's profit up to 29 February 2012 and the dividend of \$987,000 paid by CAML to CCQ in August 2011.
