Highlights

- Long interval of copper-gold mineralisation in latest drillhole: WKRC010 114m at 0.38% copper and 0.17 g/t gold (75m-189m). This hole passed through the entire interpreted 100m wide mineralised zone at this location.
- **Target geometry further confirmed** : drillholes on this section appear to confirm a mineralised zone dipping roughly 70⁰ north and about 100m wide (see section).
- **Drilling continues on other targets :** Havilah's drilling crew are presently testing other regional targets with similar signatures to the Wilkins system. Following this it is planned to deploy the drilling crew on further iron ore drilling in the vicinity.

Commenting on these results, Havilah Chairman, Dr Bob Johnson, said that Wilkins continued to surprise on the upside with such long copper and gold mineralised intervals.

"We think there are good prospects to establish a significant copper resource at Wilkins with further drilling."

"At this stage our focus has been on testing a number of similar looking targets in the region in the hope that we might discover other higher grade zones."

"We are excited by these results because this is a completely new copper-gold setting for Havilah with a great deal of promise. It might prove to be a stand-alone project or a useful addition to one of Havilah's existing copper-gold resources at nearby Kalkaroo or Mutooroo." he said.

The Wilkins prospect lies about 75km west of Broken Hill and just over 1 km south of the Barrier Highway and Transcontinental railway line.
