NuPower Promotion in China

NuPower Resources Limited (“NuPower” or “the Company”) Chairman, Mr. Bob Owen is pleased to advise shareholders that the Company is currently participating as a delegate in a promotional trip arranged by the Northern Territory Department of Mines and Energy throughout China.

On this trip, NuPower representatives have held significant engagement and discussions with a number of Chinese mining and investment groups, all of which have shown interest in the Company's wholly owned Arganara project in the Georgina basin phosphate province in Australia's Northern Territory.

The Northern Territory Department of Mines and Energy have been promoting recent discoveries made by NuPower and Rum Jungle Resources Limited (ASX: RUM) as confirmation that the Georgina Basin is a globally significant, yet hugely under developed phosphate province.

These discoveries have gained the attention of a number of Chinese state and private groups, who are very aware that the Chinese food security strategy is highly dependent on the availability of phosphate based fertilisers to ensure future food production targets are achievable.

A significant advantage of the central Australian phosphate projects is the relatively easy access to the established Alice Springs/Darwin rail link. This infrastructure is not currently constrained by capacity issues and therefore provides access for direct shipping phosphate ore (grading +30% P₂O₅) to be transported directly to the Darwin deep water port, as well as easy rail access to Western Australian and the southern states of Victoria, NSW and South Australia.

Mr. Owen stated, “The interest shown in the Company's Arganara phosphate project reaffirms the Company's decision to solely focus on phosphate due to its increasing demand. As previously announced the Company is therefore adopting a name change to **Central Australian Phosphate Limited**, to be voted on at the Company's upcoming Annual General Meeting. I look forward to updating shareholders at the meeting of any further developments that arise from the Company's promotional trip to China.”
