Commentary

Operation

The Company's outlook remains positive with continued growth expected especially in wine bottle sales, which is forecasted to improve by 166% over the period from July 2013 to December 2013 as compared to the previous half year ended 30 June 2013.

The negative operating cashflow for the month of October 2013 is largely due to prepayment of wine stock for upcoming sales.

Funding

As announced to the market on 6 November 2013, Byte Power Group Ltd completed a placement of 113,000,000 ordinary shares providing an amount of \$339,000 net proceeds to the Company. The funds were used as general working capital.

The Company continues its capital raising activities in order to address its short term working capital requirements and support the growth of the Asian business division.
