BRIERTY AWARDED A \$15 MILLION CONTRACT FROM ATLAS IRON

Civil and mining contractor Brierty Limited (ASX: BYL) is pleased to announce it has received a notice of award to undertake its first contract for Atlas Iron Limited (ASX: AGO) for the construction of approximately 60 kilometres of access road for the Abydos Mine Project, valued at about \$15 million.

The construction of the access road includes bulk earthworks, drainage and pavement layers. Works are scheduled to commence in March of this year and be completed by the end of June 2013.

Brierty Managing Director, Peter McBain, said the award of Brierty's first contract from Atlas Iron reflected the Company's continued successful delivery of other civil earthworks projects in the Pilbara.
