BIRTH REGISTRATIONS GO ONLINE IN SA

Prophecy group company Promadis, has released an innovative new module which allows parents to register the birth of newborns online, making the process quick and easy during a stressful time.

South Australia utilises the Promadis BDM for Civil Registries software system for the registration of all births, deaths and marriages in the state. The South Australian Minister for Business Services and Consumers, John Rau has announced that the online registrations facility is now being rolled out to all locations in SA after a successful pilot program at three hospitals.

"The online method speeds up the registration process significantly and reduces the waiting time for a birth certificate from two weeks down to three days," Mr Rau said. "Registering a birth online will also assist in the provision of more accurate information on birth certificates by eliminating the possibility of misinterpreting handwriting."

Once the parents have lodged the birth registration online, Births, Deaths and Marriages email them a copy of the form which they can print, sign and return to complete the process. The online birth registration service is now available for all SA parents and is free of charge. Parents in SA will also be able to use the online registration page to order and pay for a birth certificate at the same time.

Promadis BDM for Civil Registries is a very successful software application which is currently used by South Australia, Northern Territory, Australian Capital Territory, Nauru and soon, the Solomon Islands, to manage the registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages. The need for accurate, reliable and efficient keeping of vital records in the Registry is essential both in fulfilling legislative obligations as well as minimising budgets associated with running the services. New social and government considerations, including national security, have increased the demand for delivering services via a system such as Promadis BDM for Civil Registries which is both flexible and powerful to suit constantly changing needs.

Promadis has been able to deliver this new online birth registrations module to meet the requirements of the SA government in a very short timeframe and strictly on budget. The successful pilot program demonstrates the flexibility and sophistication of the Promadis solution overall. The new module has been designed and implemented to also run against solutions used by other state governments and can therefore be readily made available to upgrade service levels in all Australian states.

The Promadis solution has a very good track record of looking after the state registry needs in Australia and is set to expand further into the international scene with a deal of interest now being shown from off-shore on the back of recently winning the Solomon Islands deal announced last week.
